The Comedy Master

raises the most votes at \$10 per vote both before and at the event; (ex: 20 Votes = \$200)

The Judges' Choice

receives the highest score from our judging panel;

The Comedy MVP

raises the most overall support through votes, sponsorships and/or ticket sales.

HOW WE WILL HELP

CSC will provide you with up to 4 hours of improvisational training. Our staff will promote the event and assist you in soliciting support from your network.

WE ASK THAT YOU:

 - As many training sessions as you need to feel comfortable in your role (minimum of 2)
 - The event on October 27th
 - A post-event celebration
