FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

THE CANCER SUPPORT COMMUNITY STEPS FOR HOPE WALK HAS BEEN RESCHEDULED FOR SUNDAY, JULY 12 AT CREVE COEUR PARK. IF YOU PREVIOUSLY REGISTERED, YOUR REGISTRATION AND FUNDRAISING DOLLARS WILL TRANSFER TO THE NEW DATE.

COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS)

How are you addressing COVID-19?

The health and safety of our participants, sponsors, volunteers and staff is our top priority. We continue monitoring the situation closely and are following national and local health guidelines. This year we are excited to provide 2 participation options:

- 1. At Creve Coeur Park on July 12, social distance style! To register click here
- 2. Virtually by taking your own Steps For Hope at the location of your choice. To register <u>click here</u>. To download our virtual training guide <u>click here</u>.

We reinvented Steps For Hope in Creve Coeur Park to ensure compliance with current guidelines, including:

- Advance registration required by July 7
- Contactless distribution of registration packets via USPS or pickup at CSC
- Staggered walk start times
- Pre-packaged snacks, and lunch options from New York Toms Food Truck
- Extra spacing of the event layout

We will continue to follow recommendations for combating COVID-19. Updates will be provided here in the event additional modifications are necessary in order to comply with guidelines.

Do I have to wear a mask at Steps For Hope?

St. Louis County Department of Public Health requires wearing a mask unless you are walking and maintaining social distance. Disposable masks will be available at the check-in tent for anyone needing a mask.

What sanitizing measures will be in place at Steps For Hope?

We will have a number of sanitizing measures in place, including:

- The St. Louis County Department of Public Health recommends bringing individual hand sanitizer to use before and after restroom trips. Hand sanitizer will also available at the check-in/raffle tent, Wellness tent, Kids area tent, Eating Area tent, and VIP area
- Creve Coeur Park public restrooms have hand washing facilities
- Disposable gloves will be available at the check-in/raffle tent to anyone needing them
- At the direction of the St. Louis County Department of Public Health a mask should be worn other than when walking and maintaining social distance. Disposable masks will be available at the check-in/raffle tent for anyone needing one
- All drinks will be self-serve in individual serving bottles/cans
- Snacks will be self-serve in pre-packaged individual servings

A Health Screening form is required to be completed by every walker and turned in at the check-in tent
prior to walking. Health Screening forms will be included in registration packets. Additional copies will

What time is the walk?

To help ensure social distancing we have staggered the walk start times between 9:00am and Noon. **Prior to July 8 you need to select a walk time.** If you have registered but not yet selected a start time please email Gabby at gfish@cancersupportstl.org. We ask that you walk only at your registered walk time. Included in your registration packet is a wristband that notes your walk time. Please plan to arrive ½ hour prior to your scheduled walk time in order to allow time to check-in and turn in your Health Screening form.

Before or after you walk, be sure to enjoy many of our fun activities (please keep it safe for everyone and remember to social distance!).

What time should I arrive?

We ask that you walk only at your registered walk time. Included in your registration packet is a wristband that notes your walk time. Please plan to arrive ½ hour prior to your scheduled walk time in order to allow time to check-in and turn in your Health Screening form.

What is the cost to register?

We have 2 registration options:

- 1. <u>\$45 per person registration</u> includes a Steps For Hope t-shirt (adult sizes only), a registration wristband, and a food truck voucher for 1 breakfast or lunch item (up to \$7). Individually bottled/canned drinks, granola bars, and single serve bags of chips will also be available on-site.
- 2. \$25 per person registration includes a registration wristband, and a food truck voucher for 1 breakfast or lunch item. Individually bottled/canned drinks, granola bars, and single serve bags of chips will also be available on-site.

How do I get my registration packet?

If you register by June 30 there are 2 options to receive your registration packet:

- 1. <u>USPS</u> Register by June 30, 2020 and we will mail your registration packet to you via USPS and the address entered at time of registration; OR
- 2. <u>Contactless pickup</u> We will have your registration packet in an envelope marked with your name available for pick up in the Cancer Support Community lobby at 1058 Old Des Peres Road, St. Louis 63131 from 8am to 4pm Monday through Thursday and 8am to noon on Friday. To make arrangements to pick up your registration packet at any other time please email Gabby at gfish@cancersupportstl.org. Registration packets must be picked up no later than 6pm on Thursday, July 9.

If you Register between July 1 and July 7 your registration packet will be available for pickup only at the address and times noted above.

If I register to walk virtually will I still get a t-shirt?

Absolutely! Just pay the \$45 registration fee by June 30 and we will mail your registration packet to the address entered at registration, OR you can pick up your registration packet in the Cancer Support Community lobby at 1058 Old Des Peres Road, St. Louis 63131 from 8am to 4pm Monday through Thursday and 8am to noon on Friday. To make arrangements to pick up your registration packet at any other time please email Gabby at gfish@cancersupportstl.org.

Registration packets must be picked up no later than 6pm on Thursday, July 9.

I didn't receive my registration packet - what should I do?

If you register by June 30 your registration packet will be mailed via USPS on July 2. Please allow one week for delivery. If you do not receive your registration packet by July 9 please contact Gabby at qfish@cancersupportstl.org to make arrangements to receive a new packet.

THINGS TO BRING WITH YOU ON JULY 12

What do I need to bring/wear on July 12?

To make sure you have the best walk experience we recommend bringing/wearing the following:

- **Registration wristband** Included in your registration packet is a wristband that notes your walk time. Please plan to arrive ½ hour prior to your scheduled walk time in order to allow time to check-in and turn in your Health Screening form.
- Food voucher included in your registration packet
- Completed Health Screening form a Health Screening form will be included in your registration packet. Temperature must be taken on July 12, 2020 and must be below 100.4 degrees to participate. Health Screening forms should be completed prior to arriving at Creve Coeur Park and turned in at the check-in tent prior to walking. In the event you forget your form at home blank forms will be available at the check-in tent. To receive an emailed from prior to the event please contact Gabby at gfish@cancersupportstl.org.
- Comfortable shoes for walking
- A face mask/covering
- Sunscreen
- A hat or visor
- Individual hand sanitizer
- Weather-appropriate attire (the walk will take place, rain or shine!)
- A bottle of water or other hydrating drink
- A credit card to purchase raffle tickets or additional food. Raffle tickets can be purchased at the walk until 11am and the drawing will take place at noon
- Creative signs to show off your team's style
- Cameras or smartphones to take and post plenty of pictures

How can I access the VIP area?

What is included in the VIP area?

When is the raffle drawing?

The raffle drawings will take place at noon on July 12 at Creve Coeur Park. Whether you participate in Steps for Hope in person at Creve Coeur Park or virtually you can join in the excitement of our raffle drawing on Facebook Live. Winners do not need to be present to win.

Do I need to be present at the drawing to win?

You do not need to be present to win but we hope you can join in the excitement of the raffle drawing – either at Creve Coeur Park on July 12 or virtually on <u>Facebook Live</u> at noon.

What if something in my raffle basket is no longer available because of COVID-19?

We want to be sure that winners receive all the fun of their raffle basket! Therefore, we have made the following adjustments:

<u>Hamilton theater tickets</u> – If you added a \$100 donation to your registration and were registered to win Hamilton theater tickets, unfortunately we were recently informed by The Fabulous Fox Theater that the Hamilton tour is no longer coming to St. Louis in 2020. A \$200 Fabulous Fox Theater gift card is being substituted. The gift card can be used for any Fox Theater production, including a potential 2021 Hamilton tour.

<u>Dinner and a show</u> – Unfortunately, The Muny cancelled its 2020 season due to COVID restrictions. 2 Muny tickets (box seats) and VIP parking pass to a 2021 show are being substituted. The winner will coordinate directly with the ticket donor to select a show from the 2021 season.

HOW CAN I FUNDRAISE IN ADDITION TO WALKING, OR IF I CAN'T PARTICIPATE IN THE WALK?

Can I still fundraise if I don't attend the Walk?

Yes, talk to your human resources department to find out if your company participates in a matching gift program.


PARKING

Where do I park?

OTHER QUESTIONS

How long is the walk route?

We have 2 walk options – 1 mile and 3.7 miles.

Where does the walk take place?

The walk takes place at Creve Coeur Park in Sailboat Cove. The official starting line just to the West of the Tremayne Shelter area, and the official finish line is just to the East of the Tremayne Shelter area.

What if it rains?

The walk must go on - rain or shine, we'll be there! In the unlikely event of significant or dangerous weather conditions please check <u>here</u> or our <u>Facebook page</u> for updates.

Are pet and strollers allowed at the event?

Absolutely! Bring the whole family – even the furry ones. Please remember that pets need to be current on vaccines, and on a leash under your control at all times.
